Class Descriptions:

Welcome High Schoolers!

Secrets to Effective Writing: This program offers a comprehensive approach to improving writing skills for our newest students at the Academ. Students learn various writing techniques and apply various writing styles while developing a portfolio of their personal work. Supplies: Notebook, colored index cards

Tackling the College Application Essay: College essays are an important way for colleges to get to know students interested in attending their campuses. Welcome Middle Schoolers!

Around the World Adventure: This class offers a fun way to learn about other countries and cultures. Each week a different country is researched and discussed. Students have fun with creating wall maps, doing research and presenting interesting facts they discover. Students learn to research, present facts and work cooperatively with other students. Supplies: 1 bottle of (size and type TBD) green, black, or brown paint, paintbrush the size of a pencil.

Art: Students have fun learning creative ways to express themselves. Students learn to draft ideas, apply drawing techniques, and apply those techniques through sculpting. Students have fun using Legos and other materials in the second art project. Supplies: Legos, modeling clay (brand TBD)

Bible: A closer look into the books of Numbers and Deuteronomy is new for most students. Insights are discussed relating to what promises were given by God through the prophets and how Jesus is the fulfillment of these promises.

Chess: Students are taught the game of chess and have opportunity to play other students and instructors. Learning chess develops higher level thinking for benefit in math and problem solving.

Hebrew Ulpan: How exciting that we can learn the language of the scriptures! This friendly class submerges students in conversational Hebrew. Discussions include topics common to our middle school students such as birthdays, sports, colors and many other topics typically discussed in a day of a middle schooler.

Introduction to Biblical Leadership: Middle schools are filled with future leaders! This class assists students in developing personal goals and teaches behaviors that enable those goals such as time management, character, self esteem, self motivation and others. Leaders from the Bible are discussed to identify godly characteristics and discuss personal application.
