Hebrew 101

Description:

The Hebrew curriculum enables students to read the Bible in Hebrew. The student's understanding of deeper biblical truths is enlivened learning the language of our Savior. Students begin with an understanding of the wisdom and grace of our Almighty God. Following this foundation, students learn to read, write and recite the Hebrew Aleph-Bet both in printed letters and script. The language is broken down into simple structures starting with vowels, and then conjunctions, followed by objectival phrases. Students begin to comprehend the deep, expansive meaning of scriptures as they progress through this course.

Goals:

- Read, write and recite the Hebrew Aleph-Bet.
- Recognize and recite Hebrew words in printed letters and Modern Hebrew script.
- Read, write and recite the Hebrew vowel system.
- Begin reading, writing and reciting Hebrew words.
